- 1. God, not Caesar, is on the throne. (Chapters 4, 5; 20:10, 11)
- 2. God, not Satan, is in control. (Chapter 20:1-3, 10)
- 3. God, not man, rules the nations. (Chapter 19:20, 21)
- 4. God, not fate, luck or evil, governs the world. (Chapters 19 & 20)
- 5. God fulfills His promises. (Chapters 19-21)
- 6. All who oppose God will be utterly defeated. (Chapters 19 & 20)
- 7. When God is ready, He will simply say the word and all evil will be utterly destroyed. (Chapters 19:20, 21; 20:9)
- 8. Jesus is the triumphant Lord of lords and King of kings. (Chapter 19:16)
- 9. Christ is infinitely superior to Satan. (Chapter 20:1-3)
- 10. Jesus is Lord of the living and the dead. The dead and the living come forth when He commands. (Chapter 20:13)
