SUMMARY

- 1. To please God we must live "according to His Word" (I Peter 4:11).
- 2. The Old Testament was a shadow of the New (Heb. 10:1). If God required obedience to the pattern of the Old Testament then He requires obedience to the pattern of the New (Heb. 2:1-3).
- 3. The New Testament is a pattern or blueprint for our lives as the Old Testament was for Israel (II Tim. 1:13; Heb. 10:1, 8:5).
- 4. God's objective is our redemption and the development of each individual disciple into the image of His Son (Rom. 6:17; Eph. 4:22-24).
- 5. Through the New Testament God molds and shapes us into the image of His Son (Rom. 6:17; II Tim. 1:13).
- 6. Jesus left us an example that we should follow in His footsteps (I Peter 2:21).
- 7. Those who walk contrary to the New Testament pattern are enemies of the cross of Christ (Phil. 3:18).
- 8. If we, like Israel, do not persevere we will lose our reward (I Cor. 10).
- 9. Paul expected everyone to follow his example in Christ (Phil. 3:17; I Cor. 4:16, 17).

What is the Standard of Truth?

NOT:

- Human intuition Jer. 10:23
- Human feelings Prov. 14:12
- Human creeds Matt. 15:9
- Sincerity Acts 23:1
- Morality Acts 10:1-3
- In man, period Gal. 1:8, 9; Jer. 10:23

Truth is found only in God's Word.

"Speak only as the oracles of God" (I Peter 4:11)

"Sanctify them in the truth, thy word is truth" (John 17:17)

"All Scripture is inspired by God..." (II Tim. 3:16, 17)

"He who abides in the doctrine has both the Father & Son" (II John 9)

Jude 3

"Contend for the faith given ONCE for all" (Jude 3)

"Jesus offered up himself ONCE" (Heb. 9:28)

"It is appointed unto man ONCE to die" (Heb. 9:27)

*All three use the same Greek word – Hapax

*The purpose in each case is to prove the finality of the event.
