WHY I BELIEVE

I Peter 3:15 teaches us to, "Always be ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you..."

Are we prepared to do as God commands here? If you are a Christian, then you are certainly able to share with others the good news of salvation in Christ. As Paul teaches in I Cor. 9:22, we must adapt our approach to the needs of the individual. Before we can teach them about being a new creation in Christ (Eph. 4:24), we must first convince them about the literal spoken creation of Genesis 1.
