Isaiah in the Book of Revelation

“From the standpoint of numbers, allusions to the book of Isaiah are more abundant in Revelation than any other Old Testament book.” There are at least “seventy nine references” from Isaiah in the book of Revelation. (Ferrell Jenkins; *The Old Testament in the Book of Revelation*, pp. 62, 63)

Most of the references made by John in Revelation are in five sections:

1. The throne scene: cp. Isaiah 6 with Revelation 4, 5
2. The conduct of the wicked when the seals are opened: cp. Isaiah 2:19-21 with Revelation 6
3. The garment of Jesus dipped in blood: cp. Isaiah 63 with Revelation 19:13
4. The fall of Babylon: cp. Isaiah 13, 14, 18, 21, 47, 48 with Revelation 18
5. The new heavens and new earth: cp. Isaiah 65, 66 with Revelation 21, 22 (Ibid., p. 63)

cp. Isaiah 21:9 with Revelation 18:2

Just as ancient Babylon filled the cup of iniquity and was judged by God, so the earth’s new Babylon (spirit speaking) was full of iniquity and about to be judged.
