LESSON 4: PRIDE LEADS TO SHAME AND DESTRUCTION

THROUGHOUT THE SCRIPTURES, PRIDE (SELFISH) IS CONDEMNED, RESULTING IN PRESENT AND FUTURE SHAME AND DESTRUCTION — PROV 11:2; 16:18.

• ONE OF THE HEBREW WORDS TRANSLATED "PRIDE" (ZADON) CONVEYS INSOLENCE AND PRESUMPTION AND IS FREQUENTLY CONNECTED WITH GODLESSNESS — 11:2.

THROUGHOUT THE SCRIPTURES, PRIDE (SELFISH) IS CONDEMNED, RESULTING IN PRESENT AND FUTURE SHAME AND DESTRUCTION — PROV 11:2; 16:18.

THE OTHER HEBREW WORD TRANSLATED "PRIDE"
 (GA'ON) CONVEYS EXALTATION OR MAJESTY,
 USED POSITIVELY OR NEGATIVELY — 16:18.

THROUGHOUT THE SCRIPTURES, PRIDE (SELFISH) IS CONDEMNED, RESULTING IN PRESENT AND FUTURE SHAME AND DESTRUCTION — PROV 11:2; 16:18.

• IN CONTRAST TO PRESUMPTION AND SELF-EXALTATION, GOD CALLS US TO FEAR HIM, HATE EGOTISM, AND HUMBLE OURSELVES BEFORE HIM — 8:13; 11:2; 16:19.

THE STORY OF NEBUCHADNEZZAR SHOWS US THAT GOD IS ABLE TO WORK IN THE HEARTS OF PRIDEFUL PEOPLE, HUMBLING THEM BY DEMONSTRATING HIS OWN SUPREMACY — DAN 4:1-3.

THE DREAM OF NEBUCHADNEZZAR FRIGHTENED AND DISTRESSED THE KING, BECAUSE IT WAS MYSTERIOUS YET OBVIOUSLY INDICATIVE OF SOME KIND OF DIVINE JUDGMENT — DAN 4:4-18.

THE INTERPRETATION OF THE DREAM REVEALS THAT GOD DOES NOT ALLOW PRIDE TO GO UNPUNISHED BUT ALSO THAT THERE IS THE POSSIBILITY (HOPE) OF CHANGE – DAN 4:19-27.

 THOUGH PRIDE IS DIFFICULT TO ERADICATE FROM OUR HEARTS, GOD CAN HUMBLE US THROUGH HIS WORD (PROPHECY) AND HIS WORK (PROVIDENCE) IN OUR LIVES — PHIL 2:12-13.

THE INTERPRETATION OF THE DREAM REVEALS THAT GOD DOES NOT ALLOW PRIDE TO GO UNPUNISHED BUT ALSO THAT THERE IS THE POSSIBILITY (HOPE) OF CHANGE – DAN 4:19-27.

• LIKE DANIEL, WE MUST FAITHFULLY TEACH PRIDEFUL PEOPLE, REGARDLESS OF POSSIBLE NEGATIVE PERSONAL CONSEQUENCES, SO THAT THEY MAY BE SAVED – 4:19, 27.

THE INTERPRETATION OF THE DREAM REVEALS THAT GOD DOES NOT ALLOW PRIDE TO GO UNPUNISHED BUT ALSO THAT THERE IS THE POSSIBILITY (HOPE) OF CHANGE – DAN 4:19-27.

 GOD CHOSE TO HUMBLE NEBUCHADNEZZAR WITH PROVIDENTIAL DISCIPLINE, WHICH GOD STILL UTILIZES TODAY, THOUGH WITHOUT SPECIFIC PROPHETIC ANNOUNCEMENT – 4:20-26.

THE INTERPRETATION OF THE DREAM REVEALS THAT GOD DOES NOT ALLOW PRIDE TO GO UNPUNISHED BUT ALSO THAT THERE IS THE POSSIBILITY (HOPE) OF CHANGE – DAN 4:19-27.

 In disciplining Nebuchadnezzar, God would YET AGAIN DEMONSTRATE HIS ABSOLUTE SOVEREIGNTY OVER ALL — 4:25-26.

THE INTERPRETATION OF THE DREAM REVEALS THAT GOD DOES NOT ALLOW PRIDE TO GO UNPUNISHED BUT ALSO THAT THERE IS THE POSSIBILITY (HOPE) OF CHANGE – DAN 4:19-27.

- THE ADVICE DANIEL GAVE NEBUCHADNEZZAR IS A
 MODEL FOR ALL PRIDEFUL PEOPLE IF THEY DESIRE TO
 HUMBLE THEMSELVES BEFORE GOD 4:27.
 - 1. LISTEN TO THE ADVICE OF OTHERS, ESPECIALLY GOD.

THE INTERPRETATION OF THE DREAM REVEALS THAT GOD DOES NOT ALLOW PRIDE TO GO UNPUNISHED BUT ALSO THAT THERE IS THE POSSIBILITY (HOPE) OF CHANGE – DAN 4:19-27.

- THE ADVICE DANIEL GAVE NEBUCHADNEZZAR IS A
 MODEL FOR ALL PRIDEFUL PEOPLE IF THEY DESIRE TO
 HUMBLE THEMSELVES BEFORE GOD 4:27.
 - 2. Break away from selfishness and arrogance.

THE INTERPRETATION OF THE DREAM REVEALS THAT GOD DOES NOT ALLOW PRIDE TO GO UNPUNISHED BUT ALSO THAT THERE IS THE POSSIBILITY (HOPE) OF CHANGE – DAN 4:19-27.

- THE ADVICE DANIEL GAVE NEBUCHADNEZZAR IS A
 MODEL FOR ALL PRIDEFUL PEOPLE IF THEY DESIRE TO
 HUMBLE THEMSELVES BEFORE GOD 4:27.
 - 3. BEGIN PERFORMING ACTS OF SERVICE FOR OTHERS.

A YEAR LATER, AFTER A MOMENT OF SELF-EXALTATION, NEBUCHADNEZZAR LOST HIS MIND AND WAS DETHRONED, BUT EVENTUALLY HE CAME TO HIMSELF AND ACKNOWLEDGED THE RULE OF GOD—DAN 4:28-37.

• TO OVERCOME PRIDE WE NEED TO RECOGNIZE GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY AND OUR INABILITY TO THWART HIS PURPOSE – 4:35, 37.

A YEAR LATER, AFTER A MOMENT OF SELF-EXALTATION, NEBUCHADNEZZAR LOST HIS MIND AND WAS DETHRONED, BUT EVENTUALLY HE CAME TO HIMSELF AND ACKNOWLEDGED THE RULE OF GOD—DAN 4:28-37.

• IF WE, LIKE NEBUCHADNEZZAR, HUMBLE
OURSELVES, GOD WILL EXALT US AND GIVE
PRESENT AND FUTURE GLORY — 4:36; 1 PET 5:5-6.

THE TRANSFORMATION FROM PRIDEFUL TO HUMBLE IS DIFFICULT, BUT THE RECORD OF NEBUCHADNEZZAR SHOWS THAT IT IS POSSIBLE.

• OUR REACTIONS OFTEN MORE ACCURATELY DEMONSTRATE OUR HEARTS, WHETHER THEY ARE HUMBLE OR PRIDEFUL, THAN OUR ACTIONS DO, BUT THE MORE WE INTERACT WITH GOD, THE MORE WE WILL CHANGE – DAN 2:5, 12; 3:6, 13, 19; 4:19.

THE TRANSFORMATION FROM PRIDEFUL TO HUMBLE IS DIFFICULT, BUT THE RECORD OF NEBUCHADNEZZAR SHOWS THAT IT IS POSSIBLE.

• INTERACTION WITH GOD MUST NOT BE SUPERFICIAL, HOWEVER; WE MUST COME TO KNOW HIM AS HE IS AND WORSHIP HIM ACCORDINGLY — DAN 2:47; 3:28-29; 4:2-3, 34-35, 37.
