LESSON 5: THE WRITING ON THE WALL

BELSHAZZAR, EVEN THOUGH MENTIONED ONLY BRIEFLY IN BIBLICAL AND SECULAR RECORDS, WAS CO-RULER OF BABYLON WITH HIS FATHER NABONIDUS.

• SINCE THE SON OF NEBUCHADNEZZAR, AMEL-MARDUK, HAD BEEN KILLED IN A COUP, NABONIDUS THE SON OF A PRIESTESS CAME TO THE BABYLONIAN THRONE (C. 556 BC).

BELSHAZZAR, EVEN THOUGH MENTIONED ONLY BRIEFLY IN BIBLICAL AND SECULAR RECORDS, WAS CO-RULER OF BABYLON WITH HIS FATHER NABONIDUS.

 LATER, NABONIDUS MOVED TO ARABIA AND LEFT BABYLON UNDER THE CONTROL OF HIS SON BELSHAZZAR (C. 550 BC). BELSHAZZAR RULED UNTIL 539 BC WHEN HE WAS OVERTHROWN.

WHEN WE PROFANE WHAT IS HOLY, THE REAL ISSUE IS NOT NECESSARILY BLASPHEMOUS WORDS OR IRRELIGIOUS ACTIONS BUT IRREVERENT ATTITUDES — DAN 5:1-4.

• WHILE NEBUCHADNEZZAR HAD AT LEAST KEPT THE TEMPLE VESSELS IN A "SACRED" PLACE, BELSHAZZAR TREATED THE HOLY THINGS OF GOD AS COMMON – VV. 2-3; SEE 1:2.

WHEN WE PROFANE WHAT IS HOLY, THE REAL ISSUE IS NOT NECESSARILY BLASPHEMOUS WORDS OR IRRELIGIOUS ACTIONS BUT IRREVERENT ATTITUDES — DAN 5:1-4.

 BELSHAZZAR ALSO USED THE HOLY THINGS OF GOD TO HONOR FALSE BABYLONIAN GODS, EVEN THOUGH BELSHAZZAR SHOULD HAVE KNOWN BETTER — V. 4; SEE VV. 22-23.

WHEN WE PROFANE WHAT IS HOLY, THE REAL ISSUE IS NOT NECESSARILY BLASPHEMOUS WORDS OR IRRELIGIOUS ACTIONS BUT IRREVERENT ATTITUDES — DAN 5:1-4.

• IT SHOULD NOT SURPRISE US THAT ONE OF THE CONTRIBUTING FACTORS TO BELSHAZZAR'S IRREVERENCE WAS ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION — VV. 1-4; SEE PROV 31:4-5; LEV 10:8-11.

• THERE ARE MANY WAYS WE PROFANE OURSELVES,

WE DEFILE OURSELVES (AND OTHERS) WHEN WE INVOLVE OURSELVES IN SEXUAL IMMORALITY.

WHEN WE PROFANE WHAT IS HOLY, THE REAL ISSUE IS NOT NECESSARILY BLASPHEMOUS WORDS OR IRRELIGIOUS ACTIONS BUT IRREVERENT ATTITUDES — DAN 5:1-4.

• THERE ARE MANY WAYS WE PROFANE OURSELVES, BUT THE BIBLE SPECIFICALLY LISTS THE FOLLOWING:

WE DEFILE OURSELVES WHEN WE SWEAR FALSELY, ESPECIALLY BY FLIPPANTLY USING GOD'S NAME.

• THERE ARE MANY WAYS WE PROFANE OURSELVES, BUT THE BIBLE SPECIFICALLY LISTS THE FOLLOWING:

WE DEFILE OURSELVES WHEN WE INVOLVE OURSELVES IN IDOLATROUS AND ERRONEOUS WORSHIP.

WHEN WE PROFANE WHAT IS HOLY, WE DEMONSTRATE WILLFUL IGNORANCE AND REBELLIOUS PRIDE AND INVITE DIVINE JUDGMENT ON OURSELVES — Dan 5:5-31.

• EVEN THOUGH BELSHAZZAR WAS AWARE OF ALL THAT GOD HAD DONE TO NEBUCHADNEZZAR, HE CHOSE TO IGNORE GOD AND FOLLOW HIS OWN PLEASURES — V. 22; SEE VV. 18-21.

WHEN WE PROFANE WHAT IS HOLY, WE DEMONSTRATE WILLFUL IGNORANCE AND REBELLIOUS PRIDE AND INVITE DIVINE JUDGMENT ON OURSELVES — Dan 5:5-31.

IN WILLFULLY REJECTING KNOWLEDGE OF GOD,
 BELSHAZZAR EXALTED HIMSELF AGAINST GOD,
 INSTEAD OF HUMBLING HIMSELF AND GLORIFYING
 GOD – VV. 22-23.

WHEN WE PROFANE WHAT IS HOLY, WE DEMONSTRATE WILLFUL IGNORANCE AND REBELLIOUS PRIDE AND INVITE DIVINE JUDGMENT ON OURSELVES — DAN 5:5-31.

• GOD REVEALED THAT HE WAS GOING TO BRING BOTH BELSHAZZAR AND THE BABYLONIAN EMPIRE TO AN END AT THE HANDS OF THE MEDES AND PERSIANS – VV. 24-28.

 SO THAT WE DO NOT BECOME PROFANE LIKE BELSHAZZAR, WE NEED TO LEARN THE POSITIVE PRINCIPLES FROM HIS NEGATIVE EXAMPLE:

WE NEED TO SPEND TIME CONSIDERING PEOPLE FROM THE PAST.

WHEN WE PROFANE WHAT IS HOLY, WE DEMONSTRATE WILLFUL IGNORANCE AND REBELLIOUS PRIDE AND INVITE DIVINE JUDGMENT ON OURSELVES — DAN 5:5-31.

 SO THAT WE DO NOT BECOME PROFANE LIKE BELSHAZZAR, WE NEED TO LEARN THE POSITIVE PRINCIPLES FROM HIS NEGATIVE EXAMPLE:

WE NEED TO MAKE REGULAR ATTITUDE ADJUSTMENTS,
STRIVING TO MAINTAIN A HUMBLE HEART.

WHEN WE PROFANE WHAT IS HOLY, WE DEMONSTRATE WILLFUL IGNORANCE AND REBELLIOUS PRIDE AND INVITE DIVINE JUDGMENT ON OURSELVES — DAN 5:5-31.

 SO THAT WE DO NOT BECOME PROFANE LIKE BELSHAZZAR, WE NEED TO LEARN THE POSITIVE PRINCIPLES FROM HIS NEGATIVE EXAMPLE:

WE NEED TO REMIND OURSELVES THAT WE ARE WHOLLY DEPEND ON GOD.

ONE OF THE SUREST WAYS TO MAINTAIN A REVERENT, HUMBLE, AND OBEDIENT SPIRIT BEFORE GOD IS TO ENGAGE IN DAILY, PERSONAL (AND PUBLIC) WORSHIP.
